

Applications for the NTHGP are received and assessed by the Heritage Advisory Council, which then forwards a recommended program to the Minister for consideration. The successful projects for the 2004-05 round are listed in Table 3.

A total of **17** projects were funded to a value of \$197,083. \$2,917 was allocated to miscellaneous conservation work bringing the total expenditure for 2004-05 to \$200,000.
